

Dear Residents

** IMPORTANT - RESIDENTS ON THE EAST SIDE/OLD BURNHAM **

Due to scheduled repairs at the Water Pump Station on Wednesday, November 12, 2025- there will be no water service between 11:00 am to 4:00 pm. Once repairs are completed and water service resumed, there will be a WATER BOIL ORDER in effect. Notification of the Water Boil Order removal will come by Code Red* and a notice will be posted to our website. Burnham-il.gov *Code Red is a notification service utilized to inform residents of important notifications; Water Boil Orders (when the order is placed and lifted), Water Main Breaks, etc.

Our Lead Line Service Replacement program is moving right along. If you receive a letter from Calumet City Plumbing, you are eligible for the program at no cost-please sign up.

We continue to ask our residents and visitors to REDUCE their speed when driving thru our Village streets. Before winter arrives, the Village has scheduled about 100 trees to be serviced. Once winter arrives, any trees undone will be serviced next Spring 2026.

Monday, November 17th is the deadline to sign up for Thanksgiving Turkeys. The turkeys will be distributed on Saturday, November 22nd at the Burnham Community Center from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.

<u>Holiday Season Pop-up</u> – Saturday, December 13 th at Burnham Community Center from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm. Vendor fee \$25 sign up at the Clerk's Office Monday thru Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Toy & Coat Drive began October 1 st and continues to December 17th. Items can be dropped off at Village Hall 14450 S. Manistee Avenue. Families or individuals in need can call the Clerk's office 708-862-9150 Option 3 to sign up. Those who sign up will be contacted to come to Village Hall on Thursday, December 18 th or Friday December 19th.



HEATING AND ELECTRIC ASSISTANCE

HEATING AND ELECTRIC ASSISTANCE

HEAP - DVP

Provides a one-time benefit toward a household's heating and electric bills.

RECONNECTION ASSISTANCE

Provides a benefit up to \$1.500 to prevent imminent disconnection or to reconnect a household's heating or electric services.

FURNACE ASSISTANCE

Provides furnace repair or replacement to LIHEAP approved households whose heating system isn't working properly or is red tagged by the utility.

PEOPLES GAS SHARE THE WARMTH

WATER/SEWER BILL ASSISTANCE-*Chicago Residents*

UTILITY BILLING RELIEF PROGRAM (UBR) For City, of Chicago Residents only 50% Rate Reduction on your water, sewer and water-sewer tax bills, to Shut off, Penatities or Debt Collection on City of Chicago utility billing debt. Debt Forgiveness after successfully completing one full year in the program.

 Your most recent heating/electric/water bills.


 Proof of Social Security Numbers or ITINs for all household members.
