**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-O-003**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2024-O-006  
ENTITLED “COMPENSATION OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER”  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF BURNHAM, COOK COUNTY ILLINOIS**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1, provides that the corporate authorities of each municipality may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2024-O-006 establishes compensation for elected and appointed officials, police and fire department members, and code enforcement officers; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual salary of \$7,500.00 established by Ordinance No. 2024-O-006 is not competitive with surrounding communities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham agree that an increase in the annual salary for the Code Enforcement Officer would attract more qualified and competent candidates.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Burnham, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1:** Section 13 of Ordinance No. 2024-O-006 is amended by striking the current language and replacing with the below:

The code Enforcement Officer of the Village of Burnham shall receive an annual salary of Fifteen Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$15,000.00) payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments on the first pay day of each month.

**Section 2:** All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby rescinded and revoked to the extent of such conflict.


**Section 3:** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

**Section 4:** This ordinance shall be effective upon passage, approval and publication according to law.
